



INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAM "GAINING A ROBUST EDUCATION ACROSS TRAINEESHIPS" (G.R.E.A.T.) – A.Y. 2023/2024

WHAT DOES G.R.E.A.T. OFFER?

The Erasmus+ Traineeship G.R.E.A.T. program allows students to undertake periods of traineeship mobility abroad.

- The program includes two types of mobility: a Traditional long-term mobility with a minimum period of 2 months and a maximum of 12 months, and a Short-Term mixed mobility that combines physical mobility (from 5 to 30 days) with a mandatory virtual component preceding or following the physical one. The internships must be completed by 30/06/2025;
- The Program provides a financial contribution (scholarship) to partially cover the expenses incurred by beneficiaries during the mobility period, depending on the cost of living in the destination countries. In the case of distance mobility, the financial contribution is not provided. There are also contributions available for those with fewer opportunities and for travel expenses, as well as the availability of the advance payment of the grant;
- The program allows students to undertake traineeships in a host organization/company in one of the beneficiary countries (EU and non-EU) listed in the call;
- The destination is assigned on the basis of the applicant's position in the ranking. Host organizations are listed in Attachment I (Traditional mobility) and Attachment V (Short-Term mobility).

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

The most important requirements are the following:

- Students should be regularly enrolled for the academic year 2023/2024 in a bachelor's, master's, or single-cycle degree program, students can also undertake the internship before or after obtaining the degree;
- Students can also be enrolled in the 1st year, for the academic year 2023/24, in second-level Master's programs, Specialization Schools, and Research Doctorate programs, providing the coordinator's or director's authorization;
- Average grade of exams, weighted by ECTS, not less than 23/30;
- Minimum of 18 ECTS acquired for bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree students and 12 ECTS for twoyear master's degree students;
- Beneficiaries must undertake mobility in countries other than their own citizenship.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

Candidates must complete the application in the Esse3 system (https://unical.esse3.cineca.it/Home.do) by the deadline set for 23:59 on February 27, 2024.
